Definitions SC 1301 Title 22 Sec. 11.12	<b>School age</b> shall be defined as the period from the earliest admission age for the District's kindergarten, age five (5) by September 30 <sup>th</sup> of each school year, until graduation from high school, or the end of the school term in which a student reaches the age of twenty-one (21) years, whichever occurs first.
	SC 1302 Title 22 Sec. 11.11	<b>District of residence</b> shall be defined as the School District in which a student's parents/guardians reside.
3.	Procedures SC 1301, 1302 Title 22 Sec. 11.11, 12.1	School age resident students and eligible nonresident students shall be entitled to attend District schools.
	SC 1301, 1302, 1303a Title 22 Sec. 11.11 Pol. 203, 216.1	The District shall not enroll a student until the parent/guardian has submitted proof of the student's age, residence, and immunizations and a completed Parent Registration Statement, as required by law and regulations. The District may request, but not require, a picture ID of the parent/guardian, such as a driver's license or passport. The District may not inquire about the immigration status of a student.
