	211. STUDENT ACCIDENT INSURANCE
1. Purpose	The purpose of this policy is to ensure that a secondary general group personal accident insurance plan will be made available to pupils at the start of each school year.
2. Authority	The Board shall maintain insurance coverage by a qualified insurer over and above the first responsibility of family coverage at no cost to student for injury resulting from accidents sustained while participating in an interscholastic
Pol. 122, 123	program.
SC 511	This coverage may be waived by the school if the parent/guardian notifies the school, in writing, that full responsibility for adequate coverage for the student is being assumed by the parent/guardian.
	Costs involved as a result of injuries, athletic or other, not covered by the student accident insurance program will be the responsibility of the parent/guardian.
3. Delegation of	The Superintendent or designee shall:
Responsibility	 Prepare specifications and secure suitable coverage from qualified insurance carriers for recommendation and Board consideration. Notify all students and parents/guardians of students who may be eligible for insurance. Ascertain that, where the Board assumes the full cost of insurance, each eligible student is properly insured.
